"If you save 5 Marks a week you can own your own car!"

This enticing offer was made to the German people in 1938 when the famous Volkswagen was first introduced. Over 300,000 Germans signed up and paid weekly into a savings account that they thought would get them a VW after 3 years. But the Volkswagen factory had, already since 1936, been a part of the "4-year (rearmament) Plan" and was building only military vehicles; no cars were ever delivered. What conclusions can you draw from this?
